The Physiotherapist is also responsible for the supervision of the therapeutic mobility assistant in implementation of mobility programs and/or physiotherapy treatment.

Responsible for:

- Assessment of residents with physiotherapy related concerns such as decreased mobility, transfer concerns, range of motion, strength, balance, or pain control
- Development of individualized treatment plans based on assessment findings
- Supervision of the implementation of treatment plan by therapeutic mobility assistant
- Provide treatment services for clients using physiotherapy techniques or modalities
- Collaboration with team members such as nursing staff, physicians, social worker and occupational therapist

- Evaluates the need of assistive mobility devices and/or bracing
- Communicate effectively with family members as needed
- Educate staff regarding proper body mechanics, transfers and use of assistive devices.
